We will have two one-day raffles. Saturday will be sponsored by Fur Fun and Sunday will be sponsored by Go Dog Go!

Location

Racing will take place in the Holshouser Building at the NC State Fairgrounds. There is no room for crating inside (for exception to this rule for older/infirm dogs please see Nadine or Julie).

Racing Format

Divisions 1,2, & 4: 2 round robin 5/5

Division 3: 1 round robin 4/4 plus 1 round robin 3/3

Multibreed 1 & 2: 2 round robin 5/5 plus 1 round robin 3/3

Scoring

All races are scored as follows:

- 1 point for each heat won

- 1 additional point for winning the race

- No half points awarded for ties

- Placements are awarded based on number of points accumulated

Placement ties will be broken as follows:

- Fastest time in division

- If still tied then: fastest time head to head

- If still tied then: tie breaker race (2 of 3)
