

Welcome to March Madness 2!

Please see the other links for information about hotels, directions, and racing schedule. The racing schedule allows for 39-40 heats for the Regular teams, 40 for Multibreed, and 32 for Veterans. We have 23 teams entered and will have a one lane format.

Will we be offering single dog racing on Friday night. We plan to begin at 6pm or whenever we are done setting up. The cost is \$5 for three attempts. Each dog will be given a certificate with their times.

Due to the small number of teams entered, we will not have food onsite. However, there is food available on the fairgrounds as the cafeteria is open. We plan to have a lunch break on both days (Saturday- TBD, Sunday- after race 84).

Our judges will be Leerie Jenkins and Aimee Walker.

### Location

The tournament will be held at the Holshouser building at the NC state fairgrounds. There is no room for crating indoors (exception being the host team and any older/infirm dogs).

### Racing Format (both days)

Division 1: 2 round robin 5/5 1 round robin 3/3

Divisions 2&3: 2 round robin 4/4

Multibreed: 2 round robin 5/5

Veterans: 8 round robin 4/4

### Scoring

All races are scored as follows:

- 1 point for each heat won, ties 0.5 each
- 6 additional points for winning the race, ties 3 each
- Placements are awarded based on points accumulated

Placement ties will be broken as follows:

- Fastest time in division
- If still tied then: fastest time head to head

If still tied then: tie breaker race (2 of 3)
