Single Dog Racing

To be held Friday evening after set-up is complete. Cost is 5 runs for \$5 or 5 minutes on the mat. Dog times will be recorded and provided to the handler.

Scoring

- * 1 point for each heat won, ties 0.5 each
- * 2 additional points for winning the race, ties 1 each
- * Placements are awarded based on points accumulated

Placement ties will be broken as follows:

- * Fastest time in division
- * If still tied then: fastest time head to head
- * If still tied then: tie breaker race (2 of 3)
