Location

This tournament is held at the Herbert C. Young Community Center in downtown Cary at 101 Wilkinson Ave.

The gymnasium floor will be covered with a slip- and tear-resistant surface. All crating space must be tarped before crates are set down. The parking garage is also available for crating.

Racing Format

Regular: Divisons 1 and 3 are 5/5 followed by 3/3

Division 2 is 5/5 RR

Multibreed: 5/5 RR and 3/3 RR Divisions are combined

Open: Open1 and Open 2 are combined 5/5 RR

Open 3 will race 5/5 followed by 3/3

Vets: 4/4 RR

Scoring

- * 1 point for each heat won, ties 0.5 each
- * 2 additional points for winning the race, ties 1 each
- * Placements are awarded based on points accumulated

Placement ties will be broken as follows:

- * Fastest time in division
- * If still tied then: fastest time head to head
- * If still tied then: tie breaker race (2 of 3)

Welcome gifts will be provided to all teams (seven per team). Ribbons will be provided for all titles earned.

Warm-ups will begin at two minutes but will be reduced after every team has raced once.
